

LETTER OF PETER TO PHILIP (NHC VIII, 2)

A **Gnostic** revelation [dialogue](#) between the risen [Christ](#) and his disciples, preceded by a short letter addressed by [Peter](#) to his “fellow Apostle” Philip. The title occurs at the beginning: “The Letter of Peter which He Sent to Philip.” Jesus’ revelation consists of various topics of [Gnostic](#) mythology, concluding with a commission to the [Apostles](#) to go out and preach. Extant only in Coptic, the [Letter of Peter to Philip](#) (*Ep. Pet. Phil.*) was originally composed in Greek, probably in the early third century, possibly in Egypt.
