

MARK V

The ninety-eighth patriarch of the See of Saint Mark (1602-1618). Mark's biography in the [HISTORY OF THE PATRIARCHS](#) is two lines long. The dates of his [investiture](#) and his decease are mentioned, as is the length of his tenure. He was the contemporary of three Ottoman sultans, [Ahmad I](#) (1603-1617), Mustafa I (1617- 1618), and 'Uthman II (1618-1620). The *History of the Patriarchs* states that he was a native of the [village](#) of Bayadiyyah, and O. Meinardus places his monasticism at the Monastery of Saint Macarius (DAYR [ANBA MAQAR](#)), where he was elected patriarch. He is said to have died peacefully in 1619, but no further information is available about his burial.
